## **PROGRAM**

### **Day 1: Arrival at Dubrovnik airport – overnight in Miločer**

Landing. Vehicle pick up.

Road to Miločer situated on the Budva Riviera in Montenegro. Travel time: 2h

En route: visit Budva.

This small medieval town, the oldest in the country, in the last 10 years became the most fashionable seaside resort in Montenegro. You will be seduced by its long sandy beaches and lively social life.



Check in at the HEC Residence hotel in Miločer.

This property is 3-minute walk from the beach. Offering panoramic sea view, the hotel Residence features a rooftop pool and elegant rooms and apartments with free internet.

The hotel Residence is located in a romantic rocky area just above the main road. It is surrounded by a forest with many exotic plants such as Lebanese cedar, tropical mimosa and cactus agave.

The hotel restaurant is one of the most renowned in the country.



### **Day 2: Skadar national park – overnight in Miločer**

Breakfast.

Road to Virpazar. Travel time: 1h

Skadar is the largest lake of the Balkans, shared between Montenegro and Albania. The national park is a uniquely preserved natural ecosystem, a refuge for many birds, especially pelicans, the park's mascots.

Travel time to the entrance of the national park: 45min

There are several entrances to the park.

From the road to Podgorica take the exit “Crnojevića river”, an old fishing village with fortresses, situated on the river flowing into the lake Skadar.



From the road towards Petrovac and Virpazar take the exit “Vranjin”, the oldest town on the lake’s basin.

To fully appreciate this natural site and its landscapes, we recommend a boat trip (2 hours approximately).

Return to the hotel.

**Option for wine lovers:** visit the Šipčanik cellars. The cellars are located in a former monumental bunker from the time of Tito's Yugoslavia which harbours one of the best red wines of the country.



### **Day 3: Cetinje and Lovćen national park – overnight in Miločer**

Breakfast.

Road to Cetinje. Travel time: 40 – 45min

The town of Cetinje is located on a plateau at the foot of the mountain Lovćen. It is the former royal capital of Montenegro and the heart of Montenegrin culture. King Nicolas in 1910. transformed his principality into a kingdom. The kingdom was ephemeral, but Cetinje retains attractive mansions, former embassies... You can visit the former king's palace and an Orthodox monastery dating from Montenegro's golden age. The main street was designed as an homage to the Champs Elysées!



Our recommendations: Palace of King Nikola, the Orthodox Monastery and the Montenegrin National Museum.

Continue towards Lovćen national park.

Travel time: 20min

Take a stroll in Lovćen national park and visit the mausoleum of Prince-Bishop Njegoš, created by the great Croatian sculptor Ivan Meštrović. Lovćen national park offers hiking trails with splendid viewpoints overlooking the country. It peaks at more than 1,700 meters.



Return to the hotel.

#### **Day 4: Kotor (UNESCO) and Perast – overnight in Miločer**

Breakfast.

Road to Kotor. Travel time: 40min

Visit the old town of Kotor (UNESCO). Kotor is a fortified medieval city which built its reputation on trade and maritime transport. A meeting of cultures where you will find both Catholic and Orthodox churches.

We recommend: Saint Triphon Cathedral and the Maritime Museum.



Continue towards the town of Perast in the bay of Kotor. Travel time: 20min

The bay of Kotor has an organic appearance with steep mountain slopes, reminding of a fjord.

Visit the town of Perast.

The entire town is listed as historic patrimony. Perast is a museum village with baroque architecture and beautiful palaces witnessing the great maritime past. After a pleasant seaside stroll you can take a boat to the islet and the church of Our Lady of the Rocks located just opposite of the village.



Crossing time: 10min

Visit the votive church, built on an artificial island by the inhabitants of Perast as an homage to the icon of the virgin which, according to a legend, was found on a rock on the high seas. Austere from the outside, you will be impressed by the largest collection of votive offerings in the world and by the beauty of the baroque paintings.

Return to Perast and back to the hotel in Miločer.


### **Day 5: Ostrog monastery – overnight in Nikšić**

Breakfast.

Road to Ostrog. Travel time: 2h

Visit the Ostrog monastery.

Ostrog is the most emblematic Orthodox monastery of the country, famous by its organic architecture, enlarged and recreated through the ages. The monastery is an important place of worship for Montenegro and for the entire Orthodox community of Balkans. The miraculous relics of the mummified hand of St. John the Baptist of Trebinje (Vasilije) and many others are kept there. Clinging to the slopes of the enchanting and mystical canyon, the monastery harbours several shrines you can discover.



Continue towards Nikšić. Travel time: 30min

Check in at the hotel Trim 4\*.

The Trim Hotel is an old-style stone building set in the shade of pine trees, near the city centre of Nikšić renowned for its brewery.

You can enjoy a stroll in the woods with beautiful panoramic views of the city, tennis courts, fitness centre, wellness and spa area as well as an art gallery.



### **Day 6: The 3 lakes of the Durmitor national park, the emblematic mountain of Montenegro – overnight in Nikšić**

Breakfast.

Scenic drive to the town of Žabljak, entrance of the Durmitor National Park. Travel time: 1h30

*You will discover the three major lakes in Durmitor National Park. Mountain Durmitor is the symbol of Montenegro with 48 peaks exceeding 2000m above sea level. Its legendary peak Bobotov Kuk is 2523m high. The lower parts of the park are plateaus of meadows, then the vegetation changes in vast coniferous forests to finally give way to the high rocky peaks. The national park is protected as a biosphere reserve on international scale for its great variety of flora and fauna. The hike begins at Black Lake (Crno Jezero) at 1416m, then climbs to the mountain hamlet Bosača and continues to the steep mountainside of*

*Crvena Greda overlooking the Jabljan lake at an altitude of 1971m. While descending, you will discover the Zminje lake with its distinctive green colour.*

Effective walking time: 5h – hiking time (with pauses) : 7h – Distance : 17 km - Difference in elevation : 750 m – Level : easy 2/5



Return to the hotel.

### **Day 7: Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Sutjeska national park and Tjentište – overnight in Tjentište**

Breakfast.

Road to the town of Tjentište. Travel time: 3h30

Tjentište is located on the banks of the Sutjeska river, in the Sutjeska national park. It's the oldest national park in Bosnia (1962.) with the highest peak in the country Maglić (2386m) located on the border with Montenegro and the strict nature reserve Perućica, one of the last two virgin forests in Europe. The park is also known for the Battle of Sutjeska, World War II (1943.), when Partisans led by Marshal Josip Broz Tito defeated the German forces. In the park you will find monuments commemorating this battle.



Options to be booked in advance, half-day tours:

1. 4x4 tour on the Zelengora mountain or the Prijedor village on the foot of mount Maglić, the highest peak in the country
2. Tour in the strict nature reserve of the virgin forest Perućica with a guide from the national park. (level: easy – intermediate 3/5)



**Note:** The tours are led by park wardens with 4x4 or van vehicles.

Hotel Mladost is part of the national park. Built during the Yugoslavian period, it portrays the architecture of the time and it must be seen as a retro experience, so do not expect modern capitalist luxury :-). The rooms we propose are newly refurbished with Wi-Fi and parking included.

Overnight in Tjentište.

## **Day 8: Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina – overnight in Sarajevo**

Breakfast.

Road to Sarajevo. Travel time: 2h

Check in at the Astra Garni 3\* hotel. The hotel is a palace of the Austrian secession period, located in downtown of Sarajevo.

Visit the city-centre.

We recommend a stroll through the colourful Baščaršija bazaar with carpets and gold shops, old crafts and the Gazi Husrev beg mosque. Don't miss the Ottoman Latin Bridge near which the Archduke Franz-Ferdinand of Austria was assassinated by Gavrilo Princip on June 28, 1914. Just outside of the city centre you will find the Wilson promenade along the Miljacka river with lively bars, the cable car from Sarajevo to Mount Trebević, which reopened after 27 years. The Trebević mountain was the site of the bobsleigh course during the Winter Olympics in 1984. The bazaar is full of small restaurants offering Bosnian culinary specialties.

Sarajevo is a city offering impressive contrasts of “old” versus “new” blending with mountains surrounding the city. The result is a chaotic and captivating harmony... a unique experience.

In the morning for breakfast have a coffee – kahva and burek with the locals in Baščaršija (see explanations below). In the afternoon we recommend ćevapčići (rolls of minced meat with herbs served with a round loaf of bread called somun and with kajmak cheese) or 'sarma' (cabbage leaf stuffed with meat and rice) with mandatory 'rakija' (brandy made of plum, pear, apricot or quince).

Burek: A pie with a flaky crust filled with meat. Turkish origin.

**Pita Sirnica:** with cream cheese. **Zeljanica:** with spinach and cheese. **Krompiruša:** with spicy potatoes. We usually drink a yoghurt while eating a burek.

### **Day 9: Sarajevo – overnight in Sarajevo**

Breakfast.

#### **Recommendations in Sarajevo:**

- Beautiful views of the city from Fort Bijela Tabija and Žuta Tabija (the white fort and the yellow fort); Avaz Twist Tower viewpoint on the 36<sup>th</sup> floor; Zmajevac
- Park Vrelo Bosne which is the source of the Bosna river, the park is located at the foot of mount Igman
- Sarajevo Tunnel of Hope in which the inhabitants took refuge during the War of the 1990s. A very emotional site.

### **Day 10: Travnik – overnight in Vitez**

Breakfast.

Road to Travnik. Travel time: 1h20

Visit Travnik.

*Travnik is located in the Lašva river valley, surrounded by the Vilenica and Vlašić mountains, peaking at 1943 meters. The town is rich in religious, historical and cultural monuments. Travnik was an important settlement during the Ottoman Empire. Ivo Andrić a Nobel Prize in Literature laureate was born here, in a house located in the city centre. Travnik Fortress offers splendid views on the town below.*

Road to Vitez, travel time: 20min

*Etno Village Čardaci is located in a quiet area of the small town called Vitez, surrounded by nature. The property features an on-site restaurant that serves traditional specialties, a fishing pond, a water park and a gift shop. Free Wi-Fi and parking are provided. There is also a small wellness area offering various massages. You will discover the authentic architecture and the warm Bosnian welcome.*



Overnight in Vitez.

### **Day 11: Rama monastery and Mostar (UNESCO) – overnight in Mostar**

Breakfast.

Road to Rama lake. Travel time: 1h45

*Rama is famous for the Franciscan monastery located in a magical landscape, on an island of an intermittent lake. You can access the monastery by a narrow strip of land. The monastery has been destroyed many times in the past. The today's church of the monastery is the result of collaboration between Croatian and Bosnian artists. A nearby old house built by the monks shelters a large ethnographic and flora and fauna museum.*



Road to Mostar. Travel time: 1h40

Pass through the town Jablanica, located on the shore of the Neretva river. Here you will find the Jablanica Bridge classified as a national monument of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The bridge was destroyed by the Partisans in World War II. You can visit the site or just take a break in one of the bars and restaurants (if you are hungry you can taste the roast lamb, a local specialty) with beautiful views on the surprisingly green Neretva river.

Continue to Mostar.  
Check in at Villa Fortuna.

Surrounded by a lush garden, Villa Fortuna is located only 150m from the UNESCO-protected Old Bridge in Mostar. All rooms and apartments have air conditioning. Rooms are a fusion of the old Herzegovinian style and modern comfort.



*Visit Mostar with the bridge over the Neretva river built by the famous architect Hairudin and the bazaar. You can also visit mosques, the Herzegovina Museum and a traditional Bosnian house.*

*The city of Mostar, being a remarkable blend of Eastern and Western cultures, is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. The result of this melting pot is found in people's looks, architecture, bazaar... a puzzling atmosphere disturbing the historical benchmarks.*



We recommend the following restaurants:

- Šadrvan (next to the Old bridge)
- Labirint (on the eastern bank of the river in the goldsmith's alley, offering a beautiful view on the bridge)

### **Day 12: Pelješac peninsula and the island of Korčula – overnight in Korčula**

Breakfast.

Road to Ston in Croatia. Travel time: 2h

Follow the Neretva river to its delta, a unique landscape in southern Croatia and an impressive network of drainage canals shaping a mosaic of citrus fields.

Visit Ston.

*Ston is located on the Pelješac peninsula, on an isthmus between the open sea and the enclosed bay. A long and high medieval wall connects the two sides and the town of Ston and Ston Mali. The town's grid architecture mirrors the salt marshes on its shore.*

*Ston is renowned for shellfish farming as one of the rare sites where the Mediterranean oyster has been preserved. Oyster fields can be seen from the town of Ston Mali.*



We highly recommend lunch of oyster and mussel specialties in one of Ston's restaurants. Restaurant recommendation for indulging in an unforgettable gastronomic experience: Stagnum in the town of Ston or Mandrač, by the sea near Ston.

Drive on Pelješac peninsula to Orebić.

Travel time: 1h15

*Pelješac is the longest Croatian peninsula, a region of wild beauty with crystal clear sea and hidden bays. It is renowned for red wines, in particular Dingač produced in Potomje vineyards. We recommend to make a stop and visit a winegrower on your way to Orebić.*



Boarding the ferry connecting Orebić with Dominče on the island of Korčula (ticket included).

Crossing time: 20min

Continue towards Korčula. Travel time: 10min

Check in at hotel Liburna.

*Just a 10-minute walk from the old town of Korčula, Hotel Liburna is located on the shore of the Adriatic Sea. It features an outdoor pool and 2 tennis courts. You can enjoy your meals or have a drink on the terrace with beautiful views on the old town and the nearby islands.*



### **Day 13: Korčula, the birthplace of Marco Polo – overnight in Dubrovnik**

Breakfast.

Visit Korčula.

*Korčula embodies the spirit of the Dalmatian islands marked by the Venetian domination especially through the still active brotherhoods, part of today's tradition. Korčula is also the birthplace of the great merchant and traveller Marco Polo. A small town full of heritage and life set on a shore of the turquoise sea, a dreamer's paradise...*



*We recommend you to visit the Icon Museum, the City Museum, the Cathedral and the Palace of Bishops situated in front of the ruins of Marco Polo's house.*

Road to Dominče. Travel time: 10min

Boarding the ferry connecting Dominče and Orebić (ticket included). Road to Dubrovnik. Travel time: 2h30

Check in at hotel Uvala 4\*.

*The hotel features 51 contemporary rooms, 12 of which overlook the park, 33 with sea view and 6 luxury apartments. The hotel is located by the sea, 10 minutes*

#### **Day 14: Dubrovnik (UNESCO) – overnight in Dubrovnik**

Breakfast.

Road to Dubrovnik. Travel time: 15min

To access the old town, we recommend the local bus which stops in front of your hotel.

Visit Dubrovnik.

Dubrovnik was a Mediterranean city-state which managed to preserve its freedom and avoid conflicts by means of a very skilful diplomacy. The prosperity of the old Republic is palpable on every stone of Dubrovnik, one of the best-preserved medieval cities in the world. "The Pearl of the Adriatic" is the part of the UNESCO World Heritage.



We suggest to visit the Rector's palace, the Dominican and Franciscan monasteries, the old pharmacy and of course the outstanding walls.

Things to do from Dubrovnik:

- swimming on Banje beach, located just on the eastern part of the old town. It is the most famous beach of Dubrovnik where celebrities such as Jackie Kennedy, John Malković, Nick Nolte, Roger Moore and the Queen of England went for a dip in the blue Adriatic Sea
- take a 15 minutes boat ride to visit the island of Lokrum, a hidden gem of nature famous for the 11th century Benedictine monastery. Napoleon built a fortress on the top of the island which later belonged to the Habsburgs. The island of Lokrum also offers a rich botanical garden which is today a protected nature reserve, uninhabited, with pretty walking paths, a cafe and a restaurant. Lokrum is the favourite swimming spot for the local population.
- sea kayak tour departing from the old town, around the city walls and to the island of Lokrum or other sports activities (jet ski, parasailing, diving ...)

Road to Dubrovnik airport. Travel time: 45min
