PROGRAM

Day 1: Arrival at Split airport – overnight in Vodice

Arrival at Split airport.

Vehicle pick up.

Drive to Vodice on the scenic coastal road. Travel time: 1h30

Check in hotel Miramare 4*, a charming boutique hotel set directly by the sea, within walking distance from the town's centre with a lively atmosphere, cafes, local restaurants, shops and agencies offering recreational activities. The hotel features outdoor swimming pool and a small fitness area.

Day 2: Šibenik (UNESCO) and Krka national park – overnight in Vodice

Breakfast.

Drive to Šibenik. Travel time: 20min

Visit Šibenik. We recommend visiting the splendid Saint James cathedral.

Šibenik is a picturesque Dalmatian town founded by Croats, famous for the Saint James cathedral. The old town is an accomplishment of architecture thus earning the UNESCO Cultural World Heritage status.

We recommend visiting Saint Nicholas fortress located on an artificial peninsula in the canal connecting the bay of Šibenik with the open sea and the two fortresses overlooking the city. You can also enjoy a swim on the town's beach Banj.



Road to Skradin at the entrance of the national park Krka. Travel time: 30min

Park your vehicle in the charming town of Skradin and take the national park's boat to the Skradinski buk waterfall. You will sail upstream the Krka river canyon. Sailing time: 20min

Walk in the park on paths through the forest infiltrated by the river Krka and enjoy splendid views on the waterfalls.

Visit the small ethnographic museum presenting water mills, a forge and looms.

From there you can visit the Franciscan monastery of Visovac located on a small island in the canyon upstream the Krka river. Stroll in the upper part of the park.

Return to Vodice.



Day 3: 4x4 tour on the lake Vrana – overnight in Vodice

Breakfast.

08:30 a.m. Meet your 4x4 driver in the hotel lobby.

The 4x4 vehicle is for 6 people, the duration of the tour is approximately 6 hours, it can be modified according to client's wishes (swimming...).

You will discover the Vrana Lake nature reserve, offroad paths with breathtaking views on the Kornati National Park archipelago, ancient monuments and a traditional farm.

09:00 a.m. Arrival at the ornithological reserve, part of Lake Vrana nature reserve.

10:15 a.m. Visit of Han Mašković – a caravanserai from the Ottoman period.

11:00 a.m. Karl Stipan cave and Templar fortress visit.

11:45 a.m. Kamenjak viewpoint, short walk ending with a splendid view on the Kornati archipelago.

3:15 p.m. Return to Vodice.

The itinerary and the duration can be adapted to client's wishes.



Day 4: Eight ziplines in the Cetina river canyon and Omiš – overnight in Vodice

Breakfast.

07:45 a.m. Drive to Omiš. Travel time: 1h30

09:30 a.m. Meet our partner agency, fill in the paperwork and pick up your equipment.

Transfer by agency vehicles to the Podašpilje site (max. number of participants is 10 per group).

Instructions, handing over of equipment and zipline exercise (30min).

Walk to the starting point. Duration: 10min

Each group has 2 instructors.

Descent on the zipline system, a series of 8 ziplines, total length of 2100m. The longest zipline is 700m passing at 150m above the land.

The ziplines are connected by short paths.

Return to the meeting point and transfer back to Omiš.

Minimum age: 6 years old

Maximum weight: 140kg

Ziplines and short walks do not require particular physical efforts.

The duration of the zipline tour is approximately 2h30.

Optional traditional lunch: “under the bell” cuisine

We suggest lunch in the Kaštel Slanica agritourism, set by the Cetina river. You can taste dishes made “under the bell”. The contact and address will be written in your roadbook. The meal must be booked at least 1 day in advance.

The meal reveals the typical „under the bell“cuisine: veal, lamb and potatoes are put on a metal platter, on a bed of embers and covered with a metal bell-shaped lid. The meal is cooked for 3 hours in the stew. Food becomes crisp on the surface but melts on the inside.



Accompanied by good local wine, this experience is a genuine gastronomical pleasure!

Discover the town of Omiš.

Omiš is an old pirate stronghold with fortresses overlooking the town known for its activity and the market. The town is set in an exceptional landscape at the delta of the Cetina river and the canyon. Omiš has beautiful sandy beaches.



Return to Vodice.

Option: Canyoning in the Cetina river gorge

Instead of the hiking and the 8 ziplines tour, you can choose canyoning in the gorge of the Cetina river, one of Croatia’s tip spots for this activity!

The Cetina river formed a deep canyon with steep walls between the limestone mountains.

Canyoning will make you jump from waterfall to waterfall in an idyllic landscape where the water sculpted the rocks in beautiful organic shapes. A specialized team of instructors assists you during the descent. You will be provided with all the necessary equipment: neoprene suit, life jacket and helmet. Starting point is the village Zadvarje.

The descent lasts 3:30 to 4:30 hours.

The tour can be done for 2 physical levels: an easy level accessible to all and an advanced level with abseiling for amateur athletes.

Day 5: Plitvice lakes national park (UNESCO) – overnight in Vodice

Breakfast.

Drive to Plitvice. Travel time: 2h30

Visit the national park.

In the roadbook you will find recommendation on the best way to discover the entire park with travertine waterfalls in the upper part, the electric boat on the big central lake Kozjak and the lower canyon.

The Plitvice Lakes are located in the mountainous Lika region, near the border with Bosnia and Herzegovina. The national park is a natural phenomenon, part of UNESCO Natural World Heritage sites. It consists of 16 lakes with crystal clear waters which flow into each other in magnificent waterfalls. A paradise of nature!



A rest area is found in the national park with bistros offering drinks and simple dishes.

We advise you to buy the entrance ticket to the national park online, at least two days in advance. The link for the purchase of the tickets will be given in the roadbook.

Return to Vodice.

Day 6: Cruise in the Kornati archipelago – overnight in Vodice

Breakfast.

07:45 a.m. Drive to Murter. Travel time: 40min

09:00 a.m. Board a boat for a tour in the Kornati archipelago.

The tour lasts approximately from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Kornati National Park is the densest concentration of islands in the Mediterranean, like a puzzle game of the sea and the land. A dreamlike landscape!

Depending on the group size, the tour can be private or shared with other travellers.

A snack of grilled fish on will be served on board.

Day 7: Split (UNESCO) – overnight in Korčula

Breakfast.

Drive on the tollway to Split. Travel time: 1h

Visit Split.

The city of Split is part of the Roman emperor Diocletian palace whose presence can still be felt today. During history, buildings of different styles were added to the palace resulting in an astonishing fusion of architectural styles in constant turmoil. A walk through history...



We recommend visiting the cathedral and the biggest open-air market of Dalmatia, open every day.

Board with your vehicle on a ferry to Vela Luka on the island of Korčula (tickets included).

Departure: 05:30 p.m. – arrival 08:15 p.m.

You will cruise along the islands Brač, Šolta and Hvar.

Drive on the island through authentic Mediterranean landscapes to the town of Korčula.



Travel time: 1h

Check in hotel Marco Polo.

Marco Polo is a 4* hotel set directly by the sea, offering beautiful views on the old town Korčula. The hotel is a 10-minute walk from the old town and features an outdoor swimming pool.

Day 8: Korčula and MTB – overnight in Korčula

Breakfast.

8 a.m. - 12 p.m. MTB tour with an English-speaking guide to the village Žrnovo and Kočje nature reserve.

Level: medium

Cycle to Žrnovo, a village made of typical family hamlets located in a valley. The climb offers pretty views.

Drive in the Kočje nature reserve with a path winding between impressive rocks. A maze-like setting.

In the afternoon: Visit the old town of Korčula. We recommend visiting the Icon Museum, the City Museum, the Cathedral and the Palace of Bishops located in front of the ruins of Marco Polo's house.

Korčula embodies the spirit of the Dalmatian islands marked by the Venetian domination especially through the still active brotherhoods, part of today's tradition. Korčula is also the birthplace of the great merchant and traveller Marco Polo.



Option: Diving in the Škoji archipelago off the coast of Korčula

Instead of mountain biking you can choose a diving tour in the Škoji archipelago, protecting the town of Korčula. You will discover the beauties of the intact underwater world with crystal clear waters (among the clearest in Croatia!) Rental of equipment. Half-day tour.



Day 9: Mljet national park – overnight in Korčula

Breakfast.

Walk to Korčula and embark on a fast boat (regular line) to the town of Pomena on the island Mljet (ticket included). Sailing time: 1h

Hike in the national park on Mljet including the visit of the Saint Mary island and the 11th century monastery. Effective walking time: 3h - Hiking time with breaks: 5h
Level: easy 2/10

Visit Mljet national park (buy the entrance ticket on the spot).



According to a legend, Odysseus spent 7 beautiful years on the island of Mljet, in the arms of the nymph Calypso. Mljet is covered in pine and oak forests. The main feature of the island are the two joined lakes, connected to the sea by a narrow passage. On the bigger lake there is another island, so we have

an island on the island! This spot is perfect for swimming as the water temperature of the lakes is at least three degrees higher than the sea temperature.

The entrance ticket to the national park includes a boat trip to the islet of St. Mary and its old Benedictine monastery.



Return to Korčula by the fast boat (regular line).

Walk back to the hotel.

Day 10: Island of Hvar – hike on Hvar – overnight in Korčula

Breakfast.

Embark on a fast boat to the island of Hvar (tickets included).

Sailing time: 1h15

Please be in the port of Korčula at least 30 min before the scheduled departure time.

Hike to the Napoleon fortress overlooking the town of Hvar, 227m high. Continue on the hills along the Hvar fields and descend to the Borča bay. Possible swim stop. Walk to Hvar by a path following the coast.

Distance: 15km

Effective walking time: 5h

Hiking time with breaks: 7h

Elevation: 485 m

Difficulty: easy-medium 2-3 / 5



Hvar is an island with a very mild climate and lots of sunshine, favourable for lavender growing and extraction of essential oils used in medicine and perfume industry. Tourism developed in Hvar at the end of the 19th century, similar to Opatija and Dubrovnik. The town of Hvar is a typical Dalmatian port built in stone houses and palaces with strong Venetian influence. Hvar is an elite tourist destination attracting the world's jet setters for more than a century.

Day 11: Pelješac peninsula and Ston – overnight in Mlini

Breakfast.

Drive to the port of Dominče. Travel time: 10min

Embark a ferry to the mainland port of Orebić (ticket included). Crossing time: 20min

Drive to Ston. Travel time: 1h10

Pelješac is the longest Croatian peninsula, a region of wild beauty with crystal clear sea and hidden bays. It is renowned for red wines, in particular Dingač produced in Potomje vineyards. We recommend to make a stop and visit a winegrower on your way to Ston.

Visit Ston.

Ston is located on the Pelješac peninsula, on an isthmus between the open sea and the enclosed bay. A long and high medieval wall connects the two sides and the town of Ston and Ston Mali. The city's grid architecture mirrors the salt marshes on its shore.

Ston is renowned for shellfish farming as one of the rare sites where the Mediterranean oyster has been preserved. Oyster fields can be seen from the town of Ston Mali.

We recommend lunch in the town Ston Mali. Oyster and mussel specialties are a real treat.



Continue to Mlini on the Dubrovnik riviera. Travel time: 1h30

Check in hotel Astorea.

The Astorea hotel complex is surrounded by nature with high cypresses. The hotel features a fitness room, a wellness area, an indoor and two outdoor pools, set by the sea. Hotel Astorea is only 15-minute drive from Dubrovnik and from the airport. Wi-Fi in the lobby and spacious parking are free of charge.



Mlini is one of the most beautiful towns on the Dubrovnik riviera with pretty beaches, a seaside promenade and many restaurants.

Day 12: Dubrovnik (UNESCO) - overnight in Mlini

Breakfast.

We recommend you take the regular boat line from Mlini to Dubrovnik Old Town. You will avoid traffic jams and a search for quite expensive parking lots. By boat you will arrive directly in the old town with a splendid view on the Dubrovnik walls.

Sailing time: 20min

09:30 a.m. Dubrovnik walking tour with a local English-speaking guide (duration of the tour: approximately 1h30).

We suggest the visits of the Rector's palace, the Dominican and Franciscan monasteries, the old pharmacy and of course the outstanding walls.

Dubrovnik was a Mediterranean city-state which managed to preserve its freedom and avoid conflicts by means of a very skilful diplomacy. The prosperity of the old Republic is palpable on every stone of Dubrovnik, one of the best-preserved medieval cities in the world. "The Pearl of the Adriatic" is the part of the UNESCO World Heritage.



Things to do from Dubrovnik:

- swimming on Banje beach, located just on the eastern part of the old town. It is the most famous beach of Dubrovnik where celebrities such as Jackie Kennedy, John Malkovich, Nick Nolte, Roger Moore and the Queen of England went for a dip in the blue Adriatic Sea
- take a 15-minute boat ride to visit the island of Lokrum, a hidden gem of nature famous for the 11th century Benedictine monastery. Napoleon built a fortress on the top of the island which later belonged to the Habsburgs. The island of Lokrum also offers a rich botanical garden which is today a protected nature reserve, uninhabited with pretty walks, a cafe and a restaurant. Lokrum is the favourite swimming spot for the local population.
- sea kayak tour departing from the old town, around the city walls and to the island of Lokrum or other sports activities (jet ski, parasailing, diving ...)

Day 13: Quad in the Konavle region – overnight in Mlini

Breakfast.

Drive to the Kojan Koral centre in the vilage Radovčići. Travel time: 30min

09:00 a.m. Presentation of the equipment and instructions, 2 persons per quad vehicle.

You will start in the village Radovčići, descend to the Konavle plain, cross the river Ljuta for several times and climb to the town of Čilipi before returning along the cliffs to Radovčići.

Coffee break in the town of Čilipi in (middle of the tour) and visit the small museum of Konavle traditions. Juice or water will be served at the end of the tour.

Duration of the tour: 3 hours

Very nice and easy discovery of the Konavle region beauties!



During the afternoon we recommend a swimm in the Konavle region on the sandy beach Molunat or on the impressive Pasjača beach on the foot of the high cliffs.

Day 14: Cavtat and half-day in Mlini with a jet ski – overnight in Mlini

Breakfast.

Drive to Cavtat.

Visit Cavtat.

Cavtat is one of the most beautiful villages in Dubrovnik region. The specific natural location sheltered by two capes, was decisive for the Romans who chose this enchanting place to found the "Epidaurus" colony.

The Croats stormed ancient Cavtat and forced the inhabitants to leave. The refugees left and founded Dubrovnik, linking closely the history of the two towns. Today Cavtat is a typical fishing village with lush captains' residences. Visit the



family Račić mausoleum made by the famous Croatian sculptor Ivan Meštrović, the house of the impressionist painter Vlaho Bukovac, and the Franciscan monastery. Stroll on the beautiful seaside promenade around the capes.

Return to Mlini.

03:00 p.m. Rent a jet ski for a 1-hour tour.

Overnight in hotel Astartea.
